It was noted that the latter document outlines an updated process for implementation from October 2023, which has been revised for clarity, and is based on discussions held with the social partners, Head of Academic Affairs and Human Resources. It was noted that a revised Academic Calendar 2024/25 will be brought forward to the next meeting on 6th December for approval, in principle.
