Title of Research Project: More than a cookbook: Exploring the intergenerational influence and significance of *All in the Cooking* on Irish home cooking

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Brief overview of the Thesis topic: *All in the Cooking* was written by Josephine B. Marnell, Nora M. Breathnach, Ann A. Martin and Mor Murnaghan from Coláiste Mhuire, Cathal Brugha Street in Dublin in 1946. The book was widely used by schools in Ireland from the 1940s until the 1970s and was reprinted by O'Brien Press in 2015. While the book was initially used to teach cookery in schools it was also used in Irish homes, for multiple generations. To date, no academic study has examined the impact of *All in the Cooking* in the context of home cooking, or on the lasting impact and significance it has had. The aim of the proposed research is to investigate this intergenerational significance and influence of *All the in Cooking* on Irish home cooking.
