

4.2. Registration

Students are required to register for each academic year of their study. Registration is an online process and students will receive an invitation to register via email. Students must complete the registration process to avail of lectures, the University VLE (Brightspace), support and TU Dublin facilities. Late registration may incur late fees and refusal of facilities. Any issues with registration or payment should be discussed with the staff in the Student Service Centres who can assist with all issues related to registrations, examinations, ID cards, transcripts and other centralised services.

University, Faculty and School induction events may be arranged at the start of the first semester of the programme and the [Student's Union](#) also provides supports for students starting university.
